What is a "RAC AUDIT"?

The Recovery Audit Contractor (RAC) is a program designed to detect and correct improper past payments made on claims of health care services provided to Medicare beneficiaries.

RAC's have succeeded in correcting more than \$1.03 billion in Medicare improper payments. If you bill Medicare fee-for-service, your claims will be subject to review. This applies to both in-patient and out-patient services, in addition to long term care, durable medical equipment, and laboratories.

This seminar will assist physicians, administrators, and business office staff to focus on the opportunities for improving Medicare compliance and:

- Gain knowledge on how the RAC program operates and impacts providers.
- Learn proactive measures for preventing unnecessary risks.
